

This community was in need to access clean water, like many other communities in the northern zone of Honduras. Water in several areas of Honduras can be scarce, especially during the summer time, and we understand that water is vital to live.

The San Miguel Community only had access to the water provided by this river. Usually, women and children are the ones who collect the water to take to their homes. Unfortunately, this practice can be dangerous, since the water collected is not proper for human consumption. Animals use the water to bathe and drink, and people also use it to wash their clothes, and in some cases the dishes.

In addition, children lose precious time that can be used for their education, collecting water for their families, and the ladies too, among other disadvantages collecting water from a river carry.

The Agua Viva team and the Calvary Church team were both very well received by the community, and the excitement was shared among everyone.


Every activity we prepare in the field is an excellent opportunity to share the Word of God with everyone we encounter, and truly God manifests His glory in various ways.

The ladies from San Miguel participated in the creation of Key chains, that will remind them constantly about the Gospel of Salvation.



In the end, water is just the perfect excuse to share Jesus.







We pray for the life of Pastor Alvaro, so that God may strengthen him every day to accomplish God's mission.


